- Be accepted to an ISA Service-Learning program during a SPRING or SUMMER term.
- Have at least a 3.00 cumulative GPA.

- Scholarship Application:** (This form)
- College Transcript(s):** One official copy from each college and/or university attended. If participating in an ISA Academic Program plus Service-Learning, the transcript submitted with the ISA program application will suffice only if it is an *official* transcript.
- Essay:** Describe your commitment to community service and civic responsibility. How do you believe your contributions have impacted the people and/or the organization(s) in which you have served? How has your service experience informed your understanding of the socioeconomic environment and resulting needs of the community in which you served? Explain how you think this experience may be applicable to the community in which you will be serving abroad.

Please keep under 500 words.

- Resume:** Please include pertinent, extra curricular, volunteer and/or internship experiences including dates, hours, projects and areas of expertise.
